

Fun Free Activities in Cape May and Atlantic Counties

- 1) Cape May County Park & Zoo- Probably the most popular zoo in the area beside Philadelphia. The Kids will have a blast!
- 2) Wildwood Boardwalk & Beaches- beginning on 16th Ave in North Wildwood, and spanning nearly 2 miles to Cress Ave in Wildwood Crest
- 3) Ocean City Boardwalk – 3 miles long with many new businesses, amusements and eateries for the 2015 season.
- 4) Batsto Village in Wharton State Forrest – take a tour of the museum and learn about the ecology of the pine barrens...then tour the grounds and saw mill. Awesome time for the entire family. I've been there many times!
- 5) Cape May Sunset Beach – search for Cape May Diamonds and watch the Sunset at the Southern most tip in South Jersey. Home of the Sunken Cement Ship.
- 6) Higbee's Beach, Cape May – Grab the dog and kids to this popular and unofficial “dog beach” along the Delaware Bay.
- 7) The Forgotten Warriors Museum, Rio Grande – Take the kids to the free museum to learn about the Vietnam War.
- 8) Cape May Point State Park – Open 8:00 am to 4:00 pm. Several blazed trails lead visitors to various ponds, coastal dunes, marsh and forest habitats where wildlife can be viewed from observation platforms.
- 9) Stone Harbor Bird Sanctuary – It was created in 1947 by local ordinance. Designated a National Natural Landmark in October 1965 (the first in NJ)
- 10) Fishing and Crabbing – New 83rd Street Fishing Pier offering plenty of room for fishing and crabbing with benches, cleaning station and lights. Handicap accessibility. Some public Docks in Avalon 8th Street jetty, 20th Street & Fifth, 22nd St & Sixth, 23rd Street & Fifth, 33rd Steet, 37th Street, 53rd Street and 57th Street.
- 11) Downtown Stone Harbor's Commercial District – Take a stroll down 96TH Street and surrounding blocks for some fabulous window shopping or eat in one of the many restaurants.
- 12) Avalon's Thursday's on Dune – Every Thursday evening at 7:00 pm starting July 2nd and running until August 20th Bands will perform at the Veteran's Plaza, with giveaways and fun activities for the kids.

- 13) **Stone Harbor's Music on the Lawn** – Every Thursday evening starting at 7:00 pm beginning July 10th at 95th Street and Third Avenue. Along with free Fire Engine rides and hats for the kids at the Stone Harbor Firehouse.
- 14) **Friday Night Fireworks** – Enjoy free Friday night fireworks all summer long. Begins at 10:00 pm, enjoy a spectacular nighttime display of fireworks exploding to a musical score that is played all along the boardwalk. Launched from Pine Ave. and the Beach.
- 15) **Bird Watching** – Stone Harbor Bird Sanctuary (111th Street to 117th Streets in Stone) , Cape May State Park Observation deck, 8th Street and 1st Avenue, Avalon.
- 16) **Bicycling – Middle Twp. Bike Path** – Asphalt path that runs 4 miles, between Cape May County Park and the Community of Whitesboro.
- 17) **Cape May Washington Street Mall** – Filled with many unique shops and many restaurants to choose from.
- 18) **Avalon Big Beach Movie Night** – Every Tuesday night on the beach at 8:45 pm at 30th Street. Bring a Chair or blanket and enjoy a family movie under the stars with your toes in the sand.
- 19) **Stone Harbor Movie Night** –Family movie every Wednesday night. Call the Stone Harbor Recreation for location and times- 609-368-1201
- 20) **Atlantic City Boardwalk** –Stroll on the famous boardwalk that was constructed in 1870. Enjoy ocean views on one side and shopping, restaurants and casinos on the other.
- 21) **Atlantic City Bass Pro Shops** – Visit the unique sportsman's Sporting Goods store, with Much to enjoy. They offer a large fish tank that and lots of wild life displays throughout the entire store.
